Cook County is looking into putting a land bank together to address the foreclosure situation. Today Mayor Sherwin met with the Cook County Development Department to talk about Empire Carpets and our Senior Building. The same people in that committee are in the Land Bank Committee. Also he has been overseeing the remodeling project at City Hall.

Mayor Sherwin opened up the discussion to the public.

Robert Mack talked about the train whistles that go off in the middle of the night. Mayor Sherwin said he would try to talk to the railroad representative and see if we could resolve this situation. Mr. Mack also talked about the neighbor feeding the squirrels. Chief Koletsos asked for the name and address of this resident. Mayor Sherwin said he will look into this.

George Hainault talked about remedies for the feeding of the squirrels and birds. He also had a question about the Cook County Land Bank regarding the housing foreclosures in Northlake.
