



Our energy efficiency retrofit of the lighting along the bike path, in the parks and other areas is nearly complete. The old light fixtures were outfitted with LED fixtures which will use less energy as well as save on maintenance costs. The City received \$71,000 in funding through a grant, with the rest of the \$250,000 project to be made up through energy savings and reduced maintenance costs.



**City Continues  
to Abate Bond Taxes**

On March 18, 2013, the City Council voted to abate (suspend) the real estate tax levy for several outstanding bond issues as there were sufficient funds on hand to make the bond payment for 2013 without having to place that burden on the real estate tax bill for residents.

The City Council has been able to do this every year since the bonds were first issued and will continue this practice until the bonds are paid off.

The good news is that the 1995 bond issue (refinanced in 2003), will be paid off next year as will the 1998 bond issue (refinanced in 2008). Another bond issue is scheduled to be paid off in 2017.

The City is working diligently to manage and pay off its long term debt, and to make sure that it remains at a reasonable and manageable level. The latest City Audit (12-31-11) disclosed that the total outstanding bonded indebtedness is \$60,222,884 and is projected to be reduced to \$28,308,008 by the end of 2017, a reduction of over 50% in the next four years.

## Trees Available for 2013 Planting Season

Trees for the 2013 spring or fall planting are available. As a matter of fact, you can make a request for a tree to be planted during any time in the next 5 years. If you have room on your parkway to provide a home for a tree, call Public Works at 708-562-0940 to pick from the list of trees for planting.

Remember, trees located on the parkway or in the City's right of way cannot be cut or trimmed without permission from the City. The right of way is generally the area 20 feet from the back of the curb. If in doubt, or if a tree in this area needs attention, call Public Works at 708-562-0940.

**We provide free rides to: Target, Wal-Mart, Beauty/Barber Shops, Senior Clubs, Post Office, Banks, Grocery Stores, North Riverside Mall, (Oakbrook and Yorktown Malls are on Mondays ONLY)**

Ride reservations can be made for Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m., (except holidays and when the Township offices are closed).

Due to traffic inconsistencies, clients are required to be ready 15-minutes prior to their scheduled pick-up time and to watch for the Township car. The driver will stop at the designated address and wait briefly (5-minutes), if there is no response, the driver will leave. Our drivers are not allowed to go inside a client's home.

**Scheduling Procedures:**

- Call (708/344-8801) for reservations. Multiple stops are not allowed.
- You must call by 12:00 noon, the previous day, to reserve your appointment.
- If you are going shopping, you are allowed no more than two (2) packages.
- The rider cannot reserve travel to one location and change it with the driver.
- Each rider can have one (1) round trip per day – two (2) times per week.
- Free car transportation is provided for Proviso Township residents who are:
  - 60 years of age and older
  - Mentally challenged, who can't operate a motorized vehicle

**Due to Insurance Regulations:**

- Individuals, who are not physically and/or mentally able to get from their house to the car and destination by themselves, will not be transported unless accompanied by another individual who can assist them.
- Smoking is prohibited in all Township cars.
- Passengers **MUST** wear **seatbelts, at all times**, in Township vehicles; **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Those who cannot will forfeit their free ride.



# Springtime Preparedness

Severe weather, in the form of tornadoes, lightning, flash floods, damaging winds, and destructive hail, strike Illinois each spring, summer and fall. In some cases, we see this weather unfold with incredible violence.

2011 was a devastating year for tornadoes in the United States. There were more than 1700 tornadoes nationwide, including 59 deadly tornadoes which claimed 550 lives combined. It was the deadliest year for tornadoes since 1925. Last year's tornado season got off to a fast and early start with a rash of tornadoes in the overnight and morning hours of February 28 and 29. Those tornados affected the people of Kansas, Kentucky and the southern portion of Missouri, Illinois and Indiana. An EF4 tornado struck the town of Harrisburg, Illinois in the predawn hours, killing six and injuring around 100.

## Fast Facts

- Illinois ranks fifth in the United States for the most tornadoes per 10,000 sq. mi.
- The majority of Illinois tornadoes have occurred between April 1 and June 30, between 3 p.m. and 10 p.m.
- Last year in Illinois, there were 95 tornadoes in January and 57 in February, more than double of what occurred in the previous year.

## Siren Warning Procedures

### Attack Warning Signal

An attack warning is a three to five minute wavering siren tone. It means that an actual attack or detected missile launch against the United States has been detected and that protective action should be taken immediately. Per federal guidance: "This signal will be used for no other purpose and will have no other meaning."

### Attention or Alert Warning

An attention or alert warning signal is a three to five minute steady signal tone. The signal is used to alert the public of peace time emergencies, including severe weather. In

addition to any other meaning, this signal shall indicate for you to "turn on your radio or television and listen for essential emergency information."

The Attention or Alert Warning siren will be activated under the following conditions:

1. As reported by a trained weather spotter, one of the following has been sighted within five miles of the community:
  - a. Tornado or funnel cloud
  - b. Severe winds causing structural damage
2. The receipt of a tornado warning issued by the National Weather Service, indicating that the community is in the direct path of the oncoming tornado.

When the National Weather Service issues a warning, the sirens located in Northlake will be activated. You will hear a steady signal which lasts approximately three to five minutes. When the sirens are sounded, residents are asked to monitor local television or radio stations for more information.

The Northlake Fire Protection District and the City of Northlake test the sirens at 10:00 a.m. on the first Tuesday of every month. The Attention or Alert Warning Siren is sounded for one minute followed by the Attack Warning Siren.

## Preparing for a Tornado

Take the following actions when a Tornado Warning has been issued, when sirens have been activated or when a tornado has been sighted near your area:

- Go immediately to your predetermined shelter, basement or the lowest level of the building. In a basement, go under the stairs, under a heavy piece of furniture.
- If there is no basement, go to an interior hallway or a small interior room without windows. Stay away from outside windows and walls. Get under a piece of sturdy furniture and hold onto it. Use pillows or mattresses to protect your head and neck.

- If you are in a mobile home, get out and seek shelter elsewhere. A mobile home can overturn very easily even if precautions have been taken to tie down the unit.
- Avoid places with wide-span roofs, such as auditoriums, cafeterias, gymnasiums and large hallways.
- If you are in a vehicle, immediately exit it and take shelter in a nearby building. Tornadoes can easily lift up a vehicle and toss it through the air. Never try to outrun a tornado in a vehicle as your movement may be hindered.
- If you are outside and there is no shelter nearby, go to a low-lying area such as a ditch and shield your head. Try to make yourself the smallest target possible and beware of the potential for flash flooding.

# Skunk and Wildlife Complaints Increase

Many residents have been calling about numerous sightings of skunks, possums, woodchucks and stray cats throughout the town. There are a number of steps you can take to discourage wild life from hanging around your home.

1. Keep your grass cut and gardens trimmed of excess growth.
2. Keep your firewood in a rack at least 12 inches off the ground.
3. Get rid of accumulated junk and debris which provide hiding and nesting places.
4. Keep your garbage in cans with lids securely attached - not in plastic or paper bags, or in plastic bags in cans with no lids.
5. Don't leave cat or dog food out for your pets or neighborhood cats.
6. Fill in all voids under storage sheds - these animals love to nest under sheds. Your shed should be built on a solid concrete or gravel base with wood retainers.
7. Patch all holes in your garage or shed siding to make sure these animals don't set up winter residence in your garage or shed.
8. Close off any access under your porch or low lying deck.

Remember, these few simple steps will encourage this urban wildlife to move on. Your cooperation is appreciated. In the meantime, if you are experiencing problems with these animals, call Public Works at (708) 562-0940 for assistance.






