**MINUTES OF THE APRIL 9, 2014 MEETING:**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. **YOUTH DANCES** –Sheila reported that our last dance on 5/2 only had 11 kids in attendance. We took in \$33 & had a loss of \$192 after paying the DJ. Due to the ongoing lack of interest, we will not continue them next year. Once Northlake Days is over, we will begin brainstorming for other events that we can run for the youth of our city. We may try a game night for younger kids (3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grades with younger kids allowed if parents stay) every other month possibly with the DJ. Sheila & Rebecca will check the garage for our game stock. We think we have quite a few.
2. **MOVIE-IN-THE-PARK** - Sheila informed us that, despite what we were told, we cannot change our movie title. Unknown to the person she spoke with at Veteran's Park, Kathy had already done considerable work to find the movie & props to go with it. Our movie title must therefore remain "Walking With Dinosaurs". This event is set for 7/18.
3. **NEW COMMISSIONER NOMINATION** – Sheila will resubmit her request to nominate Richard Martinez to fill our remaining commissioner slot. It has not yet come up on a City Council agenda & she fears it was mislaid. She hopes that it will be added to the agenda for Monday's meeting.
4. **NORTHLAKE DAYS** –Rebecca & Sheila have yet to make a presentation to Mayor Sherwin about the Bull & the Money Chamber. It is essential that they do so soon, since Northlake Days is now only a month & a half away. Sheila will put in a request for \$600 for crafts & supplies for the Win-it-in-a-Minute game to get us started. Rebecca volunteered to contact the clowns so see if they can help again this year. Sheila also wondered if the clowns or possibly Triton Troupers might be able to help with Boofest make-up . . . a great idea to pursue when planning that event.
