OLD BUSINESS:

1. **KIDS' GAME DAY EVENT – 8/29** – Sharon reported that she bought candy at Sam's for the piñata. We have extra bags from a Valentine craft event for the kids to use for the loot they pick up. She also found lots of small toy items from past events to go inside such as: balls, key chains, bunny figures, and Mardi Gras beads. Many items were also found that can be used as prizes for games like Bozo Buckets.
