WAIVER AND RELEASE**

You are solely responsible for supervising your dog and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity to participate in. You must understand that you and others who accompany you are participating in this activity at your and their own risk (and risk of your dog). Dogs and permit holders of varying degrees of skill, training and experience use this facility.

You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog are physically fit and/or adequately skilled to use this facility. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before undertaking any dog training or exercise activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog and its owner/handler. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death, to either the dog, its owner/handler or other persons or animals. Dogs are pack animals and when "off lead" even the best-training dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to you, another person or dog. Other risks include, but are not limited to the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner/handler; the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slip and falls, premises defects, equipment failure, failure in instruction/supervision and all other circumstances inherent to dog and/or outdoor activities.

Should you attempt to break up a dog fight or restrain a dog, including, but not limited to your dog, you may be attacked and severely mauled by your dog or the other dog, or attacked by another dog's owner/handler. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the City of Northlake to guarantee absolute safety.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this facility, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I recognize and acknowledge that use of this facility and the surrounding area for dog activities and participating in dog activities entails certain risks of damage; loss or injury to animals, persons or property (including to me, other persons, my dog and other dogs or animals), and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of and responsibility for any injuries, damages, loss, liability, costs and expenses, regardless of severity, extent or amount, that (a) I, my dog or any other person accompanying me might cause, sustain or incur as a result of my presence in this facility and surrounding area or any participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of this facility and surrounding area or (b) any other person or animal might sustain as a result of my or my dog's actions or conduct in connection with or arising out of my presence in this facility and surrounding area or my participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge (a) the City of Northlake and its officials, employees and agents, and (b) any volunteer assisting or working on behalf of the City of Northlake and any of its officials, employees and agents from any and all claims or causes of action for damages, injury, loss, liability or expenses that I may now cause or have or which may accrue hereafter to me or any other person claiming through my or on my behalf and arising out of connected with, or in any way associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend (a) the City of Northlake and any of its officials, employees and agents, and (b) any volunteer assisting or working on behalf of City of Northlake and any of its officials, employees and agents from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions and expenses (including, but not limited to court costs and attorney fees) occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my use of this facility and surrounding area, including without limitation any losses, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions and expenses on account of personal injury to or death of any person or animal, or damages or property of any person or entity, including, but not limited to (a) the City of Northlake and any of its officials, employees and agents, and (b) any volunteer assisting or working on behalf of City of Northlake and any of its officials, employees and agents.

I HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE IMPORTANT INFORMATION, WARNING OF RISK, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. IF REGISTERING ON-LINE FOR VIA FAX, YOUR ON-LINE OR FACSIMILE SIGNATURE SHALL SUBSTITUTE FOR AND HAVE THE SAME LEGAL EFFECT AS AN ORIGINAL FORM SIGNATURE.

City of Northlake - Dog Park Rules

- ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK!
- CLEAN UP after your dog(s)! Dispose of waste in cans provided.
- Dogs must be wearing a current rabies tag. The owner must be wearing their Dog Park Permit. Permit applications are available at City Hall.
- Dog owners who do not comply with the rules will be subject to fines of up to \$1,000. The City of Northlake Police and Leyden Animal Control will conduct periodic monitoring and video surveillance.
- NO DOGS KNOWN TO BE AGGRESSIVE toward people or other dogs (or exhibiting any threatening behavior) may enter the park. Leash your dog immediately if aggressive behavior is observed at which time your dog may need to be removed from the park.
- Handlers can be held CRIMINALLY LIABLE for any injury inflicted by their dog(s), to humans or other dogs!
Under "The Ryan Armstrong Law" Public Act 093-0548 (Illinois State law)
- Homeowners/Renter's insurance is strongly recommended!
- Dogs must always be under VOICE CONTROL!
- CLOSELY SUPERVISE your dog(s) and be within view. Do not leave your dog(s) unattended.
- Leash your dog(s) while entering/exiting the park.
- Handlers must have LEASH IN HAND when their dog is off leash.
- No Children under the age of 11 years of age. Children 11-17 must be accompanied by an ADULT.
- Maximum 3 dogs per handler.
- NO CHOKE/PINCH COLLARS are allowed in the park.
- No ELECTRONIC training devices are allowed.
- Female dogs in HEAT are not allowed.
- NO UN-NEUTERED MALE dogs over 1 year old.
- NO FOOD, Rawhides, or Pig ears allowed as dog fights may result.
- DO NOT allow dogs to DIG.

Remember, these rules are for you and your dog's safety! Anyone not obeying these rules may be asked to LEAVE THE PARK by anyone!
